A Child and Youth Violence, Bullying, and Abuse, Prevention/Health Education Curriculum "Survive & Thrive Skills Training"

YouthAlert! (YA!) Program is universal comprehensive violence prevention education "+" designed to reduce child and youth violence and lower levels of all violence in a community and its related costs. Violence is a powerful force but fortunately, there are equally powerful forces to overcome it. YouthAlert! (YA!) Program fully utilizes; the power of a child's and youth's physical, mental and emotional capabilities, the power of all the having all the information, the power of each person's individual internal identity, the power of free will, and the power of true choice.

In addition, there is enough top-tier evidence-based research available to enable us to reach all children and youth and help them with their risks, victimization, and rehabilitation. YouthAlert! (YA!) Program puts them all into practice and it all successfully comes together with a school-based, universal, cross-cutting, violence, bullying, and abuse, prevention skills training and health and life skills education program.

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YouthAlert! (YA!) Program Guests and Volunteers

Adults/Parents/Guardians/Family/Friends

- Adults, parents, guardians, family, friends of the students are welcome free-of-charge to join and patriciate in the YouthAlert! (YA!) Program.
- At the discretion of the school instructor, YouthAlert! (YA!) Program can provide the instructor and class with an adult invitation.
- YouthAlert! (YA!) Program is where adults and children and youth and adults meet halfway to substantially reduce violence, bullying and abuse. Adult participation increases this impact greatly.
- Each class, school, and school district have different policies regarding adult guests, so adults must familiarize themselves with those polices. These polices is what governs adult presence and participation in the YouthAlert! (YA!) Program.

Volunteers

- YouthAlert! (YA!) Program brings in many unpaid volunteers to assist in the program.
- YouthAlert! (YA!) Program performs background checks on their volunteers or gets volunteers from reputable organizations who have already fully vetted the volunteer.
- Volunteers include both youth volunteers and professional volunteers.
- Volunteers often come from sponsors of the program who share with children and youth; personal experiences, professional expertise, and advice.
- YouthAlert! (YA!) Program trains and supervises all volunteers in the program.
- Volunteers only contact with children and youth is directly through the YouthAlert! (YA!) Program.

YouthAlert! (YA!) Program includes an in-class moderator and presenter, but the narration is only one-third of the entire program. The program brings in many youth and adult *volunteers* and *speakers* to help form a "crew" which is essential not only to the instruction but to student involvement, discussion, and training. Preference is given to male adults and U.S. minorities.
